 - Identification and Notification of close contacts
 - Responder Information
 - Community Testing
 - Declaration Status
 - Barry County – Emergency declaration on 03.23.2020.
 - Barry OEM/EOC – Activated per the emergency declaration
 - Barry County Health Department – **Emergency Public Health declaration effective June 30 – October 31, 2020**
 - **Phase 2 Mitigation Rules in effect July 16 – December 31, 2020**

- Missouri - Governor Parsons declared a State wide emergency on March 13, 2020
- United States – President Trump declared a National emergency on March 13, 2020
 - Stafford Act declaration if for Category B Emergency Protective Measures. Additionally President Trump has activated the Defense Production Act.
